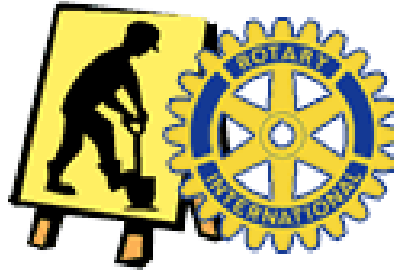


DISTRICT 5300 PRESENTS
