Interact is a Rotary sponsored service and social club for young people ages 14-18. The program gives young people an opportunity to participate in fun and meaningful service projects while developing leadership skills and meeting new friends.

Interact is one of the most significant and fastest growing programs of Rotary International, with over 239,000 members in more than 10,400 Interact clubs in 108 countries and geographic areas.

Interact clubs plan, finance, manage, and complete at least two service projects annually – one that serves their school or community, and another that furthers international understanding and goodwill. Sponsoring Rotary club members offer guidance and assistance.



Interact Symposium

The Symposium is an outstanding opportunity for Rotary Liaisons, Interact School Advisors, Interact Club Presidents, and other club officers to improve leadership skills, exchange ideas about how to make an Interact club successful, and share fellowship.



The Symposium is a three-day program that is held in a local camp setting. It has provided information and training to thousands of participants since it was first held in 1993. New and old Interact clubs from seven adjoining Rotary Districts in California and Nevada are invited to participate in the Symposium, which is led by experienced Rotary and student leaders. The program is similar to Rotary's President Elect Training Seminar.

The Program

Interactive training sessions include Community Service, International Service, Teambuilding and Leadership Skills, Membership Development, Club Management, Fundraising, and Communications. The Symposium includes motivational Rotary

speakers, fellowship, fun, idea exchange, and exhibits.

The workshops are informative, inspirational, and practical. They are specifically designed to help clubs become more effective. Everyone enjoys the training, the fellowship, and the opportunity to make new friends.
