# The Annual Programs Fund



- The Annual Programs Fund is the main source of funding for programs of The Rotary Foundation (TRF) and of the grants and international programs of District 5300.
- Your donations are used by TRF to offset expenses and then are used to fund programs after three years.



# TRF World Fund



- 50% of your donations are used by TRF's World Fund to fund:
  - Group Study Exchange Teams
  - International Matching Grants
  - Health, Humanity and Hunger Grants
  - World Peace Fellowships
  - Disaster Recovery
  - Other Humanitarian Programs



# Rotary Peace Fellowships



- Fellowships are paid by TRF World Fund.
- Nominations can be made from our District.
- Rotary Peace Fellows are awarded 15-24 month fellowships to earn master's degrees in Peace and Conflict Resolution.
- They study at one of five Rotary Peace Centers all over the world and complete a summer internship in the field.

# 2012 Matching Grants



- \$90,000 Available for District 5300 Match
  - Five \$10,000 limit Matching Grants (MG's)
  - \$5,000 limit for remaining MG's
- District 5300 will match club contributions **1 to 1**.
- TRF will match District contribution **1 to 1** and club contribution **1/2 to 1**.
- A \$5,000 Club project becomes a \$17,500 international project.

# 2012 District Simplified Grants



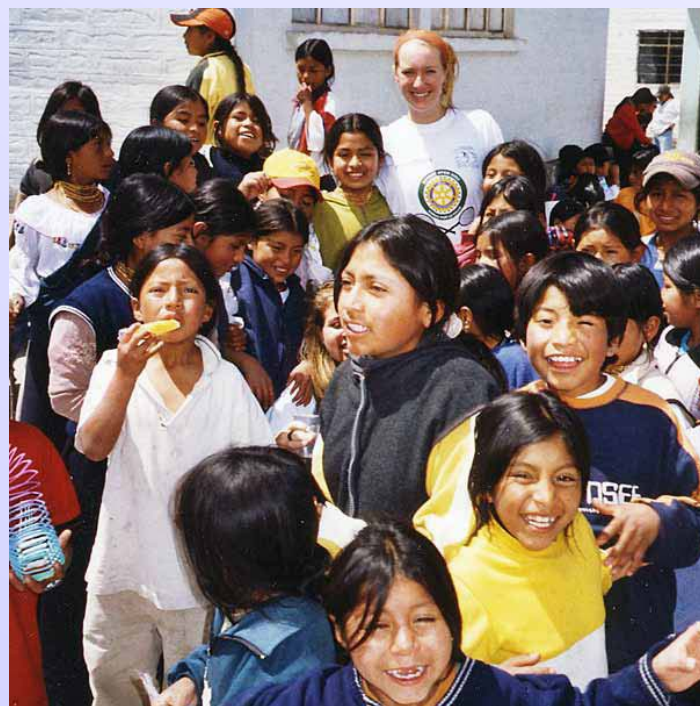
- \$33,000 Available.
- Maximum match of \$2,000.
- Club funds are matched 1:1.
- Available for:
  - New projects to your clubs
  - “Hands on” projects only
  - Can be local or international



# 2012 Ambassadorial Scholars



- District 5300 will be selecting 4 Ambassadorial Scholar candidates on April 30.
- Maximum scholarship is now \$27,000.

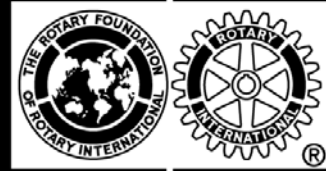
# 2012 Group Study Exchange

- Each club should encourage participation in the Paul Harris Society (\$1,000 annual contribution to APF).



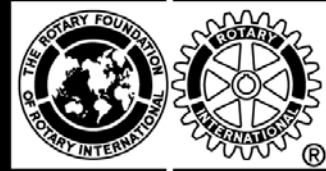
# Supporting TRF
