1. PURPOSE

2. MISSION STATEMENT

The District encourages research, education, skill development and dialogue to enhance the understanding and practice of managing of conflict and promoting peace. Welcoming participation by people of all backgrounds and religious traditions, the District adheres to the tenants of Rotary International and its values of reconciliation, service, appreciation of diversity, personal transformation and integrity, and nonviolence and peace-building.

3. ELIGIBILITY

Individuals, including Rotarians, and organizations may be nominated by Rotary Clubs in District 5300 with equal consideration.

4. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Please submit the following materials, using the guideline below, by February 11, 2012.

A. Nomination Form

The cover page of your nomination materials should be the completed Nomination Form.

B. Nominee's Resume

The nominee's resume or biography, describing background and concrete examples of significant contributions.

C. Letters of Support

News or magazine articles written by or about the candidate and no more than three letters of support from individuals or organizations.

D. Procedural Guidelines

The nomination form and your attachments are the SOLE basis for the nomination. Materials will not be returned.

5. PRIZE AND TROPHY

6. Each organization and individual who are selected for the Rotary International District 5300 PEACEMAKER OF THE YEAR AWARD, will receive a \$1,000.00 prize and a trophy with the award designation.

7. USE OF THE AWARD

The monetary award is to be used at the sole discretion of the awardees to further the work of the individual or the organization in their continued role in peacemaking and peace-building.
