ENTRY DETAILS AND RULES TO HELP YOU COMPETE FAIRLY

- Your art will represent your thoughts on the 2024 theme "Creating Peace, Hope, and Healthy Minds." Show the judges what makes you feel peaceful, hopeful, and healthy.
- Your art must be no larger than 11" X 14" (landscape or portrait).
- Your art canvas thickness should not exceed 1/4 inch.
- All entries <u>must incorporate</u> a Rotary International or Rotary Interact symbol or logo clearly visible within the artwork. Previous winning entries and two example logos are on this page to assist you. <u>The logo must be part of the artwork</u>, not attached to the artwork.
- Media Choices: oil, pastel, charcoal, graphite, pen and ink, watercolor, marker, mixed media, graphic design, or photography.
- Students may submit one entry per media choice.
- Submitted artworks with names placed on the front of artwork will be disqualified.
- Winning selections will be displayed January 27, 2024 at the Rotary Peace Conference held at the Richard Nixon Library in Yorba Linda, CA from 9:00 AM 1:00 PM and on the Rotary District 5300 and 5330 Web pages: www.district5300.org and www.district5330.org.
- Entries become the property of Rotary International and will not be returned to the artist, so take a photo of yourself with your artwork prior to submission.
- Each winner's award check will be presented at the Peace Conference to the student or student's school or Rotary Club representative.
